

Chick Pattern

No. 11. Needles

Double Knitting Wool



Base and body.

Cast on 24sts.

Knit 1 row.

P1.K1. into first st. K10. (K1.P1. knit wise.) repeat once. K10. K1.P1 in last st. (28) sts.

Knit 1 row.

P1.K1. into first st. K12. (K1.P1. knit wise.) repeat once. K12. K1.P1 in last st. (32) sts.

Knit 1 row.

P1.K1. into first st. K30. K1.P1 in last st. (34) sts.

Knit 1 row.

P1.K1. into first st. K15. (K1.P1. knit wise.) repeat once. K15. K1.P1 in last st. (38) sts.

Knit 3 rows.

P1.K1. into first st. K16. (K2.tog .) repeat once. K16. K1.P1 in last st. (38) sts.

Knit 3 rows.

P1.K1. into first st. K16. (K2.tog .) repeat once. K16. K1.P1 in last st. (38) sts.

Knit 3 rows.

P1.K1. into first st. K17. K2.tog. K17. K1.P1 in last st. (39) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Cast off 11sts. K1. K2tog. 3 times. K1. K2tog. 3 times. K2. cast off remaining 11sts. (11) sts.

Head.

Rejoin wool to the 11 sts. and Knit 1 row.

K1. (K1.P1. into next sts. K1.) repeat to last st. K1. (16) sts.

Knit 10 row.

K2.K2tog. to end. (12) sts.

K1.K2tog. to end. (8) sts.

K2tog. to end. (4) sts.



Make up.

Sew eye to face.

Make two loops for the beak for duck. (=)

Sew head, back and side seams of duck.

Sew a running stitch between the head and body.

Place stuffing into head. Pull running stitch up tightly and fasten off.

Tie ribbon round neck of duck.



You can use this pattern as a basic guideline, please feel free to experiment with colours, wool & decoration!
